








NARRATIVE FOR (B) SERGEANT JOSEPH R LAFLOWER

Ref: 14-48-AR

On 3/18/2014 at 1900 hours I was assigned to be on duty at the Selectmen's meeting per Chief Spiewakowski. For the past few meetings there has been some problems with an attendee, Brian Corriveau, who has been called out of order and becomes loud and boisterous, disrupting the order of the meeting. About two meetings ago, Mr. Corriveau was removed from the meeting by Chief Spiewakowski and me at the request of the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen after he was declared out of order and asked to stop speaking and he continued to speak in a loud and boisterous tone.

On 3/18/2014 Mr. Corriveau, who is a candidate for the office of selectman, was allowed to speak during a comments and concerns session and he began to become loud rehashing what he has said in previous meetings. After a few minutes he was advised that he was campaigning by Chairman Downing and that he has been told before that he cannot campaign in a selectmen's meeting. Mr. Corriveau denied he was campaigning and again began to become loud. He was advised that he was out of order by the Chairman and that if he did not stop speaking that he would be removed. At this time Corriveau stated "he did not want to breath the same air" and walked to the back of the room and sat down.

The Chairman then recognized another citizen who got up and stated that he was tired of Mr. Corriveau interrupting the meetings all the time and stated he disagreed with Corriveau's views of the Select Board. At this time Mr. Corriveau stood up and began trying to engage the citizen in a conversation, denying that he interrupts the meetings. He was advised by Chairman Downing to stop and again advised that he was out of order. He continued to interrupt the citizen who was talking. He was again advised by Chairman Downing to stop, that he was out of order and that if he did not stop he would be removed. Mr. Corriveau stopped and sat down.

A few seconds later, Mr. Corriveau began commenting loudly from the back of the room and was called out of order again by Chairman Downing who then asked me to remove Mr. Corriveau from the meeting. Mr. Corriveau left willingly without incident. I followed him out into the hallway and advised him not to re-enter the meeting room.

At this time I am requesting that the court schedule a show cause hearing to determine if probable cause exists to charge Brian Corriveau with Disturbance of Schools or Assemblies in violation of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 272 Section 40.
